We, the NeNa-Network (Claudia Seefeldt, Tobias von der Recke, Herwig Thelen, Stefan Ofner, Bruno Körner und Martin Lemme), presented a workshop which assessed the necessary fundamentals for creating networks and the resulting questions about international networks. The resulting notions, the discussion within this particular network, as well as the outcome of our discussion led to the idea of a meeting in order to discuss and develop ideas. - Possible results can be presented and discussed at the sixth international conference in Linz (Austria)

Invited are all those who work with the concept of new authority and want to exchange and network with others.

The meeting is intended by us to be characterized by self-organization within a provided frame (open space format) with the participants being responsible for the content. We will organize the location and firstly present the ideas and findings from our workshops.

The meeting will take place, no matter how many participate. A maximum of 200 people can take part.

Participation is free. The participants are responsible for their own care. We provide coffee, tea and water for a fee of 20,00 €.

We will devise a nice setting for Saturday evening and will make further plans as soon as we know the approximate number of participants.
